We have received the following donations: The Frances Brietner Trust in the amount of 6,312.91, this is the remainder of the trust for which we received \$14,000 in June bringing the total donation to over \$20,000. Lynne Lyons donated \$500.00 in Memory of Mary Anne Graves.
We have received \$405.00 of a \$450.00 grant from Michigan Humanities to fund our "Let's Talk About Great Writing" authors.

The Director of the Leelanau Township Library in Northport, Nellie Danke is moving to the Suttons Bay Library to become their director. The Leelanau Township Supervisor has asked me to chair their search committee once again to find her replacement.
